A local law ~~... AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH AND THE COUNTY OF CLINTON TO ENTER INTO A CO-OPERATIVE AGREEMENT PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 119-M OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW AND PRESCRIBING THE FORM AND TERMS OF SAID AGREEMENT.~~

Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the

~~SECTION 1.~~ SECTION 1. In accordance with the provisions of Public Law 85-432 of the United States of America, which is designed to combat poverty in the United States of America, there is hereby authorized as a joint venture between the City of Plattsburgh, and the County of Clinton, the following Co-operative Agreement, which is entered into subject to the provisions of Section 119-M of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT made this 17th day of December, 1964, between the COUNTY OF CLINTON, a Municipal Corporation, and a sub-division of the State Government of the State of New York, Party of the First Part, and THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, a Municipal Corporation, duly organized, existing and operating under the provisions of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902, as amended, with its principal place of business in the City Hall, Plattsburgh, New York, Party of the Second Part.

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the covenants hereinafter set forth, the parties do hereby mutually agree as follows:

1. There shall be organized by the contracting parties hereto, a joint economic opportunity Council, which shall consist of twelve (12) members, of which the Mayor of the City of Plattsburgh, and the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, shall be ex-officio members, and five (5) of which members shall be appointed by the Mayor of the City of Plattsburgh and five (5) of which shall be appointed by the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors. The Chairman of the Council shall be appointed by the Mayor of said City and the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, after selection by the full Council.

4. The said Council shall have the right and authority to request assistance and receive grants under the provision of Public Law No. 55-431 or any other statute of the United States or the State of New York, which authorizes public assistance for projects within the territorial limits of the said City and County, provided, however, that no such project shall be authorized by the said Council without the consent of the governing body of the jurisdiction within which said project is to be performed. The said Council may also receive and take such action as may come to them by appropriation from the County of Clinton and the City of Plattsburgh, or gifts from private citizens, or such gifts as may be received by bequests.

5. The said Council shall have the authority to expend such funds as it may have in its possession, or appropriated to it and for purposes appropriated thereto.

6. The City Chamberlain of the City of Plattsburgh, shall act as the fiscal officer of said Council, and shall have custody and control of all funds which may be paid out only upon vouchers duly audited by the said Council, or a Committee of said Council appointed for that purpose.

7. The said Council shall have the power to fix the amount of the Bond of the said fiscal officer, and to obtain Public Liability Insurance to protect the activities of the Council, its members, officers, employees, or servants.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the County of Clinton, through its Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, has hereunto set its hand and affixed the seal of the County of Clinton, and the City of Plattsburgh, through its Mayor, has hereunto set its hand and the seal of the City of Plattsburgh has been duly affixed thereto by the City Clerk of the City of Plattsburgh.


