Pursuant to the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York and Article 5 of the County Law of the State of New York.

<u>SECTION 1.</u> <u>LEGISLATIVE INTENT.</u> It is the intent of the within local law to increase the efficiency and professionalism of county government by extending the term of County Legislators from two (2) years to three (3) years.

SECTION 2. Commencing at the general election in November, 1997, County Legislators will be elected to a three (3) year term of office which initial term shall start on January 1, 1998.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Local Law shall become effective only if approved by the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors voting upon the Local Law at the general election to be held in November, 1996. If so approved, it shall become effective immediately.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk of this Legislature shall transmit the form of the proposition, which shall contain a brief statement of the text of said Local Law and its number, to the Clerk of the Board of Elections. Thereafter, a sufficient number of copies of such proposition and abstract shall be printed and made available to the electors at

the time of registration or otherwise in advance of election, and in addition, a sufficient number of copies shall be delivered with other election supplies, and distributed to the electors at the election, and in the event the local law is approved by an affirmative vote of the majority of the qualified electors voting upon the local law at the general election held in November, 1996, the Clerk of this Legislature be, and the same hereby is, directed to renumber same as the appropriate local law of the Year 1996.
