NARRATIVE: On the above date and time, Clinton County Sheriff Deputies arrested Tanner R. Reome on the above-listed charges following investigation of a motor vehicle crash that was reported to the Sheriff's Office on April 8, 2024, at around 2:45am. On that date, Deputies responded to a report of a vehicle found abandoned and heavily damaged on Tom Miller Road in the Town of Plattsburgh. Investigation revealed that Reome was allegedly operating a 2013 black Mercedes C Class sedan on Tom Miller Road when the vehicle collided with a deer and exited the roadway. It's alleged that Reome fled the scene and then traveled to an address in the City of Plattsburgh where he contacted law enforcement by phone and reported the Mercedes as stolen. It's alleged that Reome impersonated an acquaintance when he made the false report to law enforcement.

DISPOSITION: Reome was processed at the Sheriff's Office, following which he was issued appearance tickets and returned to the custody of Clinton County Correctional Facility where he is currently being held on charges from an unrelated incident. He is set to appear in Plattsburgh Town Court and Plattsburgh City Court on a later date in connection with the arrest. Deputies were assisted at the initial accident scene by Town of Plattsburgh District 3 Fire Department. Deputies were also assisted in the investigation by the Plattsburgh City Police Department.
