WEIGHTING FACTORS - ADT=45% ROUGHNESS=10% SCORE=45%

KEY TO SURVEY

ADT	0 - 500 = 5
(TRAFFIC COUNT)	500 - 1000 = 4
45%	1000 - 2000 = 3
	2000 - 5000 = 2
	5000 + = 1

ROUGHNESS	HIGH = 1
10%	MEDIUM = 2
	LOW = 3

SCORING	1 = VERY POOR - ROAD IS IMPASSABLE
45%	LARGE POTHOLES, WIDE AND DEEP CRACKS
	2 = VERY POOR - EXTREME DETERIORATION
	3 = POOR - DISTRESS IS VERY FREQUENT AND VERY SEVERE
	4 = POOR - DISTRESS IS FREQUENT AND SEVERE
	5 = POOR - DISTRESS IS FREQUENT AND MODERATE TO SEVERE
	6 = FAIR - OCCASIONAL TO FREQUENT DISTRESS WITH MODERATE SEVERITY
	7 = GOOD - INFREQUENT TO OCCASIONAL DISTRESS WITH SLIGHT SEVERITY
	8 = GOOD - INFREQUENT DISTRESS VERY SLIGHT SEVERITY
	9 = EXCELLENT - NO DISTRESS
	10 = EXCELLENT - RECENTLY CONSTRUCTED OR REHABILITATED

- NOTES:**
1. Scoring is based on an "average" of conditions throughout an entire section of road.
 2. Scoring is across both lanes.
 3. Bridge decks are ignored when scoring.
 4. Roads can only be scored a 10 if construction or rehabilitation is less than 1 year old.
