## INSTRUCTIONS

### 1. INSURANCE COVERAGE

Minimum insurance requirements are set out in the attached Schedule A titled "General Insurance Requirements, Clinton County, dated December, 2003." Additional insurance requirements may be mandated at the time of application review. The Permittee is responsible for insuring that all insurance requirements as directed by the County Superintendent of Highways are complied with.

Expiration of, or lack of, liability insurance automatically terminates the permit.

### 2. INDEMNIFICATION

To the fullest extent permitted by law, Contractor and any subcontractor shall indemnify and hold harmless the Owner, its Legislators, representatives, agents and employees from and against any and all claims, suits, liens, judgements, damages, losses and expenses, including legal fees and all court costs and liability (including statutory liability) arising in whole or in part and in any manner from injury and/or death of any person or damage to or loss of any property in connection with the performance of any work or any other act or omission by or for Contractor or Subcontractor, pursuant to any contract Purchase Order and/or related Proceed Order. For any such claims, suits, liens, judgements, damages, losses and expenses Contractor and any Subcontractor shall defend and bear all costs of defending any actions or proceedings brought against the Contractor or Subcontractor and/or Owner, its Legislators, representatives, agents and employees, arising in whole or in part out of any such acts, omission, breach or default. The foregoing indemnity shall include injury or death of any employee of the Contractor or Subcontractor and shall not be limited in any way by an amount or type of damage, compensation or benefits payable under any applicable workers compensation, disability benefits or other similar employees benefit act.

The Contractor and Subcontractor hereby expressly permits the General Contractor to pursue and assert claims against the Subcontractor for indemnity, contribution and common law negligence arising out of claims for damages for death and personal injury.

### 3. GENERAL

Applicants for Special Hauling Permits for vehicles that have a gross weight of 18,000 pounds or more must obtain a HIGHWAY USE TAX STICKER from the Highway Use Tax Unit, NYS Department of Taxation and Finance, State Campus, Albany, New York, for the permit to be valid.

This permit is only valid for highways under the jurisdiction of the Clinton County Superintendent of Highways. Permission must be obtained from the appropriate authority when traveling over Thruway, Parkway, State Roads, Town Highways, City or Village Roads.

The applicant agrees to assume all responsibility and liability for damages to persons or property that may occur during movements of the vehicle or combination of vehicles, through negligence of himself, his agents or employees or from any other causes and to save the County of Clinton harmless therefrom.

The permit is revocable without hearing or necessity of showing cause, either before or during movement.

### 4. AXLE WEIGHTS AND SPACING

Axle Weight: List the total weight of each axle when the vehicle is loaded and ready to move. The axle weights when added together must equal the total gross weight.

Axle Spacing: List the distance between each axle (center to center of axle), starting with axle distance 1 to 2. If more room is needed, attach additional sheet.

### 5. MOVEMENT TO ORIGINATE AND TERMINATE

From: List the location in the County where the load is to originate. If from out-of-county, list the border county/state/country from which you will be entering Clinton County.

To: List the location in Clinton County that you are transporting the load to. If you are going through the county with the load, list the border county/state/country to which you are going.

### 6. REQUESTED ROUTING

List the routes you would like to travel, from the origin to destination. If more room is needed, attach additional sheet.

### 7. FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY

**DO NOT WRITE IN THIS SPACE.** This space is used to tell you what routes you can travel, how long your permit will be effective, and what restrictions and requirements will be necessary for you to comply with to move your load on the County roads.

### INSTRUCTIONS FOR REQUESTING A PERMIT

- This permit may be mailed or hand delivered to: Clinton County Highway Department, 736 Route 3, Plattsburgh, NY 12901. This is the **only** location which will process this permit request.
- Permit applications must be submitted 10 days prior to move, to allow for processing. You must have this permit in order to travel on the County road system.
- All requested information must be completed for us to process your permit.
