**NARRATIVE**: On the above date and time, Sheriff's Deputies responded to the intersection of State Route 374 and the western end of the Wallace Hill Road in the Town of Plattsburgh for a report of a two car motor vehicle collision with injuries. Investigation at the scene revealed that Emily Bond was operating a 2010 Toyota Corolla south on Wallace Hill Road when she attempted to cross over Route 374 to continue south on the Wallace Hill Road extension. Bond failed to yield the right of way to and was struck by a 2020 Chevrolet Equinox being operated by Margaret Shutts which was traveling west on State Route 374.

**DISPOSITION:** Both operators were transported to UVM CVPH Medical Center for treatment of injuries. A juvenile passenger in the vehicle operated by Emily Bond was also transported to the hospital. Both vehicles were towed from the scene. Emily Bond was ticketed for failure to yield the right of way at a stop sign. Deputies were assisted at the scene by District 3 Fire Department, Morrisonville Fire Department, UVM CVPH EMS and Morrisonville EMS.
