NARRATIVE: On March 27, 2021 at approximately 12:01PM, Clinton County Sheriff's Deputies responded to a two car personal injury accident at the intersection of Smithfield Blvd and Bank Street in the Town of Plattsburgh. Robert O. Brooks, who was operating a 2012 GMC Terrain, was traveling north on Smithfield Boulevard and allegedly failed to yield the right of way by turning west in front of oncoming traffic, colliding with a 2016 Hyundai Sonata traveling south on Smithfield Boulevard. The operator of the Sonata, Brandon A. Ryan, denied injury and was signed off from receiving medical treatment at the scene by EMS. The operator of the GMC, Robert O. Brooks was transported to CVPH Medical Center for evaluation after complaint of knee and neck pain.

DISPOSITION: At the time of press release, Brooks was listed in stable condition at CVPH Medical Center, where he was being treated for his injuries. Brooks was issued a ticket for failure to yield the right of way while turning left and is scheduled to appear in court at a later date to face the allegations. Clinton County Sheriff's deputies were assisted by the District 3 Fire Department, Morrisonville EMS, Morrisonville Fire Department and CVPH EMS.
