**NARRATIVE**: On the above date and time, Clinton County Sheriff's Deputies conducted a traffic stop on State Route 3 in the Town of Plattsburgh involving a vehicle that allegedly failed to stop at a stop sign. The operator of the vehicle, later identified as William D. Curtis IV, initially provided a false identity and was determined to be operating a motor vehicle while his ability was impaired by alcohol. Curtis was also operating outside of the requirement for an interlock device and possessed a revoked driver's license in the State of New York for a previous DWI conviction within the preceding ten years.

**DISPOSITION:** Curtis was processed at the Sheriff's Office and issued appearance tickets returnable to the Plattsburgh Town Court where he will appear on a later date to face the allegations.
