NARRATIVE: On September 15, 2021, at 2:07PM, Clinton County Sheriff's Deputies responded to Community Bank at 468 Route 3 in the Town of Plattsburgh for a report of a vehicle that struck the building and left the scene. Upon arrival, it was found that a vehicle had struck a pillar at the entry way while attempting to leave a parking space and then left the area.

DISPOSITION: Sheriff's Deputies were able to locate the operator of the vehicle, Terry Lieberth, upon further investigation into the property damage accident. Lieberth was ticketed for Leaving the Scene of a Property Damage Accident, Unsafe Backing and Unregistered Motor Vehicle.
