### *Key Note Speaker: ANGELA SHELTON*

In 2001 Angela made her directorial debut with the documentary *SEARCHING FOR ANGELA SHELTON*. She interviewed other Angela Sheltons in an effort to survey women and inadvertently put a spotlight on sexual abuse when she discovered that seventy-percent of her namesakes had been victims. This led to appearances on The Oprah Winfrey Show, Larry King Live, 48 Hours Investigates, NPR, Lifetime Television and the cover of the New York Times.

Since 2004 Angela has become an expert in trauma informed care and travelled the world as an internationally recognized social activist raising money for rape crisis centers and domestic shelters as a public speaker. She brings humour and levity to the heavy subjects of child sexual abuse, rape and domestic violence and shares fun and easy ways for survivors to heal and for service providers to work more profoundly, staying grounded and healthy in order to help even more people. Angela has spoken in Congress, universities, military bases, high schools, elementary schools, community centers, conferences and seminars nationwide and abroad. Angela kept her promise to practice what she preaches and moved on from 24/7 trauma herself, got married and had a child, and then went back into the ring of making films. Angela balances making movies, speaking and being a mom while living in the country and traveling to the city.
