To receive additional credit on an examination as a non-disabled or disabled veteran,			

The "Armed Forces" of the United States are defined as the Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Air Force, Coast Guard and the National Guard when in service of the United States. Such service must be or have been on a full-time active duty basis, other than for training purposes.

## GENERAL INFORMATION:

- A non-disabled veteran is entitled to five (5) additional points on an open-competitive exam or two and one-half (2.5) points on a promotional exam. A disabled veteran is entitled to ten (10) additional points on an open-competitive exam or five (5) points on a promotional exam.
- An applicant has two months from the examination's last filing date to provide civil service with the proof of eligibility for additional credits.
- Additional credit cannot be added after the eligible list is established.
- Additional credit can only be added to a passing score.
- An applicant may withdraw the credit at any time up to appointment.
- An applicant currently in the armed forces may request and receive <u>conditional</u> credit but must meet all criteria for such credit prior to its use.
