

This is a position in the Clinton County Health Department that involves responsibility for the organization and implementation of community based efforts regarding public health needs utilizing the concepts of public health prevention including public information, referral, community education and outreach.

Qualifications: Either: (a) Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with a Bachelor's Degree in health education, health science, public health, health promotion, community health, or health communications; OR (b) Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with a Bachelor's Degree in education, nursing, epidemiology, wellness and fitness, or nutrition and one (1) year of experience in health education; OR (c) Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with a Bachelor's Degree in marketing, human services, social work or psychology and two (2) years of experience in health education; OR (d) Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with a Master's Degree in public health or health education.

This title has been approved without the need to take an exam for a one year period ending September 24, 2024, through the HELP Program of the NYS Department of Civil Service. Candidates appointed permanently to this title will NOT need to take an exam and will remain in their position even when the HELP Program ends.

Position starts at \$49,442/yearly and includes a full benefits package.
