**NARRATIVE:** On the above date, Sheriff's Deputies responded to Target in the Town of Plattsburgh for a larceny complaint. The suspect, Rachael Todd, had allegedly attempted to leave the store with an amount of merchandise and fled after being confronted by Target employees. Deputies located Todd in the Town of Beekmantown subsequent to a traffic stop, at which time Todd was allegedly operating the vehicle with a suspended license.

**DISPOSITION:** Todd was processed at the Sheriff's Office and released after being issued appearance tickets. She is set to appear in Town of Plattsburgh Court on a later date in connection with the larceny charge and Town of Beekmantown Court for the vehicle and traffic law offenses.
