**NARRATIVE:** On July 2, 2016, Sheriff's Deputies arrested Ashley Kaczmarczyk on the above-listed charges following a traffic stop in the Town of Peru. Kaczmarczyk is alleged to have operated her vehicle while in an intoxicated condition and with a Blood Alcohol Content of .18. She also allegedly kicked a Sheriff's Deputy during the incident, resulting in her being charged with 2<sup>nd</sup> degree harassment.

**DISPOSITION:** Kaczmarczyk was transported to the Sheriff's Office for processing and was released after being issued appearance tickets. She is set to appear in Town of Peru Court in late July for arraignment on the charges.
