**NARRATIVE:** On October 2, 2014, Sheriff's Deputies responded to the area of Military Turnpike and Tom Miller Road in the Town of Plattsburgh for report of an unresponsive male in a motor vehicle. On scene, Sheriff's Deputies found Andrew P. Juneau unconscious at the wheel of his vehicle on the Military Turnpike and also found him to be in possession of a synthetic drug commonly known as "spice" or "K2". It's alleged that Mr. Juneau had been using the synthetic drug while operating his vehicle, causing him to lose consciousness. Juneau was transported from the scene by Morrisonville EMS to CVPH Medical Center for evaluation and later released.

**DISPOSITION:** Andrew was arrested in relation to the above incident on October 12, 2014 and issued appearance tickets. He is set to appear in Town of Plattsburgh Court on a later date to face the allegations.
