A Plattsburgh juvenile accused of burglarizing a local building was taken into custody by Clinton County Sheriff's Office deputies and is now facing felony charges.

Deputies arrested a 14-year-old male juvenile on December 4, 2010 at around 4:30p.m. after receiving a report that he broke into a local building and allegedly made off with property not belonging to him. The juvenile is also accused of trying to return the stolen property at a local store for money.

Deputies charged the male juvenile with one felony count of 3rd degree burglary and one misdemeanor count of petit larceny. He was released into the custody of his parents and is due to appear in Clinton County Family Court at a later date to face the charges.
