On Thursday January 28, 2010 Sheriff's deputies arrested a Plattsburgh man who was driving a vehicle owned by his employer and charged him with DWI.

42-year-old Daniel Loveless of Plattsburgh was arrested by deputies shortly after midnight- on route 22 – just south of the Plattsburgh International Airport.

Deputies' en-route to another call spotted Loveless driving a Twin State telephone van on route 22 – with its license plate lights out.

The van was subsequently pulled over and that's when deputies discovered Loveless in what appeared to be an intoxicated state.

Loveless failed a field sobriety test administered by deputies. He was subsequently placed under arrest and taken to the Clinton County Sheriff's department for processing. During processing - Loveless voluntarily submitted to a breath test - which revealed a blood alcohol level 2-times the legal limit.

Loveless was charged with one misdemeanor count of DWI. He was released to a third party and will appear in Plattsburgh Town court at a later date to face the allegations.
